Hamlet Garcia, II, is a pro se non-prisoner seeking in forma pauperis status to appeal the district court's orders denying his motion to intervene as a defendant in a lawsuit, barring him from submitting any filings without an attorney, and striking documents that he filed. He now moves this Court to reconsider its September 23, 2025, order denying in forma pauperis status. After careful review, Garcia's motion for reconsideration is DENIED, as he has offered no new evidence or arguments of merit to warrant relief.
